



Educational Seeding Grants to Help You Get Started

To further support teachers using Texas Instruments technology, Teachers Teaching with Technology, T³ Australia, is offering seeding grants of up to \$2,000 to school clusters.

These seeding grants are to be used in a way that further enhances the effective use and implementation of Texas Instruments technology in schools. For example:

- To facilitate 1-2 days of hands-on workshops for teachers in regional areas
- As a seeding grant for a mini conference (not all sessions need to involve technology)
- To facilitate opportunities for one or more teachers in isolated regions to visit other schools/regions/states who are using the technology in a well established manner
- Other ideas welcome!

T³ Australia will be looking for the following when making selections:

- The number of teachers and schools who will directly benefit from the grant
- Sharing of information and skills gained to other schools in local community
- The degree to which the activity or event will enable teachers to move forward in their use and application of the technology
- The merit of the activity or event in it's own right

Seeding grants will be awarded twice yearly with deadlines on 30th June and 10th December of each year.

All activities and events associated with the seeding grant must be completed within nine months of the grant being awarded.
