

Downloading Data Files into a TI Calculator

With the use of TI Connect™ and a computer-to-calculator cable, educators may download data files for use with the Math and Science @ Work problems. By downloading these data files into your own calculators, you can then distribute to students by linking the calculators and sending the files.

If you do not have TI Connect™ or a cable, you may download the software for free from the Texas Instruments website. You may need to purchase the needed cable. You can also receive more detailed instruction on using TI Connect™ at <http://education.ti.com>.

Basic instructions are as follows:

- Connect your calculator to the computer.
- Open TI Connect™ and select TI DataEditor from the menu.
- Next, open the data files provided.
 - To open them all at once, from the File tab, select Open, browse to where you have them saved, select all of the files while holding down the Shift Key, then select Open.)
- From the Actions tab select Send All Lists.
(If you did not clear any previous data from the lists in your calculator, then you will get a warning message that data already exists on the device. In this case, select Replace All and it will write over the data.)
