# Money Moves

## Activity 1 Exploring Narrative Composition

## Materials

- ◆ TI-83 Plus
- ◆ TI External Keyboard
- ◆ Teacher Guide: **Thoughts on Money** (transparency)
- ◆ Overhead Projector

### *Activity Overview*

Students give thought to the fact that the money in their pockets has had many homes. As such, students participate in a class discussion on this topic.

### *Directions*

#### *Before the Activity Begins*

Make an overhead transparency from the Teacher Guide included at the end of this activity, **Thoughts on Money**.

Ensure that students have their devices and keyboards ready for recording information. Students will be taking notes in class in a new NoteFolio™ file. If necessary, review the process for displaying a new NoteFolio™ file using the procedure supplied in this activity.

#### *During the Activity*

Begin the activity by displaying the **Thoughts on Money** transparency. Review the quotes on money to provoke discussion and underscore the topic of the lesson.

Hold up a \$1 bill for all students to see. Ask students to tell you where they think it has been. Write students' guesses on a transparency on an overhead projector. Without fail, this type of discussion proves fun and productive.

#### *After the Activity*

Instruct students to record the \$1 bill's travel itinerary in a new NoteFolio™ file on their graphing handheld. When the file is complete, they should save it for

future reference. Students may want to refer to it for inspiration during the next activity.

### ***Accessing the NoteFolio™ Application on the TI-83 Plus***

The following procedure enables you to access the NoteFolio™ application, assuming that the application is already installed on the device.

Note: The NoteFolio™ application is most efficiently used on the TI-83 Plus with the TI Keyboard.

1. Turn on the graphing handheld and press

**[APPS]** to display the list of installed applications. Using **[↑]**, **[↓]**, highlight **NoteFlio** from the application list.



2. Press **[ENTER]** twice to clear the NoteFolio™ introduction screen and display a new (blank) NoteFolio™ file.




3. Students should complete the exercise in the opened file.

4. When students have completed their work, have them save their files by selecting **Menu** (pressing **[GRAPH]**), using **[↑]**, **[↓]** to highlight **Save As**, and pressing **[ENTER]**.



5. Press **[CLEAR]** to remove any text that may appear in the **File name** box on the **Save As** screen. Type the new file name.



6. Select **OK** (press **[Y=]**) to save the file.
