What Is the World Geography Facts Application?

World Geography Facts is a handheld software application (App) for the TI-83 Plus that presents facts about every continent and virtually every country in the world. Multiple-choice quizzes test students on several topics, including:

- General information
- Capitals

Location

Highest Points

Religion

• Language

Students can use the App as a study and review tool. They can tailor the quizzes by choosing the continent, the topic, and the number of questions in the quiz.

Starting and Quitting the Application

Starting the Application

- 1. Press <u>APPS</u> to display the list of applications on your calculator.
- 2. Select **WorldGeo**. The application's information screen is displayed.
- 3. Press any key. The programmer's screen is displayed.
- 4. Press any key. The REFERENCES screens are displayed.
- 5. Press any key. The application's Main Menu is displayed.

Quitting the Application

Press [2nd] [QUIT] or select **ESC** (press the GRAPH key) repeatedly until you return to the Main Menu.

Select **Exit** from the menu.

Navigating

 To select an option defined at the bottom of the screen (such as ESC associated with the GRAPH key), press the graphing key directly below the option.



- To return to the previous screen, select **ESC** by pressing the GRAPH key, or press 2nd [QUIT].

Studying Facts

The Main Menu

There are four different options presented on the Main Menu.

- Geography Facts lets you study facts and maps.
- Quiz lets you take a quiz over the material.
- About displays the application's information screen.
- Exit closes the application.
- 1. Select Geography Facts. The Search by: screen is displayed.



2. Select the name of a continent, highlight the name, and press ENTER. The Countries screen is displayed.



- 3. To select a country, use and to scroll through the list. When the country's name is highlighted, press ENTER.
- TipTo quickly find a specific country's name, pressALPHAand the first letter of the name.

Facts on each country include:

Religion

- Area (in square km)
- Climate
- Lowest point
- Highest point
- Population

- Literacy rate
- Life expectancy
- Capital
- GDP per capita (gross domestic product) (USD)
- Currency

Using Maps

Maps are displayed differently depending on whether you are viewing a continent or a country. You can select **MAP** by pressing the ZOOM key.

Continent

You can view a map of a continent to associate its name with its shape.

- **Note** When an outlying country is close, it appears on the Continent map. Example, when you move the cursor up on North America, you can see Russia.
 - 1. From the Main Menu, select Geography Facts.
 - 2. From the Search by: screen, highlight a continent's name and select **MAP**. The map of the highlighted continent displays.
- TipTo display more information, press TRACE to display
an x cursor. Use the arrow keys to move the cursor.
The name of a country or body of water is displayed
when the cursor is on it. Press TRACE again to return
to the previous map view.

3. Press 2nd [QUIT] to return to the Search by: screen.

Country

You can view a map of the selected country to find its location within its continent.

- 1. From the Main Menu, select Geography Facts, select a continent, and select a country.
- 2. Select **MAP** by pressing the ZOOM key.

A map of the selected country displays. The country's name is displayed, and an \mathbf{x} cursor identifies the country's location within the continent.

3. Use the arrow keys to move the **x** cursor to any country, ocean, or sea.

The name of the country or body of water is displayed when the cursor is on it. Move the cursor to the edge of the display to view portions of the map that are not visible. You are viewing relative positions of the countries.

- **Note** The cursor might not be apparent if several countries are close in proximity. Move the cursor to see its location.
 - 4. To close the map and return to the facts screen, press [CLEAR] or press [2nd [QUIT].

Taking a Quiz

After you have studied or reviewed the necessary facts, the World Geography Facts App lets you choose the material for a self-quiz.

- **Note** Do not press ENTER until you have made all of your selections.
 - 1. From the Main Menu, select **Quiz**. The Quiz screen is displayed.



- Press → or
 to scroll through the continent names in the Scope menu. You can select World to include all continents. When the name of the continent you want appears, press
- 3. Press → or < to scroll through the topic names in the Topic menu. When the topic you want appears, press <.

4. Press → or < to display either 5 or 10 questions in the Questions menu. When the number of questions you want appears, press → to highlight Take Quiz and press ENTER.

TipAlternatively, you can press ZOOM or TRACE to selectTAKE QUIZ.

Now the quiz begins. The next screens present questions with four possible answers.

1. Select **A**, **B**, **C**, or **D** to select your answer. (Press the graphing key below the option.)

The World Geography Facts App gives you immediate feedback. If you answer incorrectly, the application displays both the incorrect and correct answers.

2. Select **NEXT** to continue.

Continue to answer the questions. If you want to leave the quiz, select **ESC**.

When you have answered the last question, your Quiz Stats are displayed, listing the number of correct answers, number of questions, and percent correct.

- 4. Select **QUIT** to return to the Main Menu, or select **ESC** to select another quiz.
- Note If the Quiz question is about the religion of a country and two answers are (Christian) and (Roman Catholic, Protestant), one could argue that Christian encompasses Roman Catholic and Protestant, but the best answer is really Roman Catholic and Protestant since that is what is listed in the Geography Facts.

Deleting the Application from Your Calculator

- 1. Press [2nd] [MEM] to display the MEMORY menu.
- 2. Select Mem Mgmt/Del.
- 3. Select Apps.
- 4. Move the cursor to **WorldGeo**.
- 5. Press DEL. A confirmation message is displayed.
- 6. Select **Yes** to delete the application.

Installation Error Messages

Low Battery

Do not attempt to download a Flash application if the low-battery message appears on the home screen. Low battery indication is shown on the initial screen. If you receive this error during an installation, change the batteries before trying again.

Invalid Signature or Certificate

Either this calculator does not have a certificate to run the application, or electrical interference caused a link to fail. Try to install the application again.

Error in Xmit

This problem is usually associated with the unit-to-unit cable and its connection between the calculators. Make sure the cable is firmly inserted in the link port of each calculator.

Link Transmission Error

This error indicates that the TI Connect[™] or TI-GRAPH LINK[™] software is unable to communicate with the calculator. The problem is usually associated with the TI-GRAPH LINK cable and its connection to the calculator or to the computer.

- Make sure the cable is firmly inserted in the calculator's link port and the computer's serial or USB port.
- Verify that the correct cable type is selected in the software link settings.
- Verify that the correct communications port (Com Port) is selected in the software link settings. (This step does not apply if you are using the USB port and TI Connect software).

Archive Full

This error occurs when the TI-83 Plus does not have sufficient memory for the application. In order to make room for another application, you must delete an application or archived variables from the TI-83 Plus. Before you delete an application from the TI-83 Plus, you can save it on your computer using TI Connect[™] or TI-GRAPH LINK[™] software for the TI-83 Plus. You can reload it to the TI-83 Plus later using the TI Connect or TI-GRAPH LINK software.

Other Errors

See the "Error Conditions" section in Appendix B in the <u>TI-83 Plus</u> <u>Guidebook</u> for information about the specific error.

Checking Version Numbers and Free Space

Verify Operating System Version and ID Number

The World Geography Facts App is compatible with the TI-83 Plus operating system 1.15 and higher.

To verify your operating system version number:

- 1. From the home screen, press 2nd [MEM].
- 2. Select **ABOUT**.

The operating system version number is displayed below the product name and has the format x.yy. The ID number appears on the line below the product number.

Verify Flash Application Version

The version number appears on the information screen below the application name. To display the information screen, do one of the following:

• Press APPS, and then select WorldGeo.

— or —

• Select About from the application's main menu.

Check Amount of Flash Application Free Space

- 1. From the home screen, press [2nd [MEM].
- 2. Select Mem Mgmt/Del.

The World Geography Facts App requires at least 49,152 bytes of **ARC FREE** (Flash), or three spaces, to load the application.
