European Union [EU] Ecodesign for Sustainable Products – Disclosure of Unsold Consumer Products for TI

Regulation (EU) 2024/1781 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 13 June 2024 establishing a framework for the setting of Ecodesign requirements for sustainable products, amending Directive (EU) 2020/1828 and Regulation (EU) 2023/1542 and repealing Directive 2009/125/EC (Text with EEA relevance), and is applicable in all 27 EU member states as well as European Economic Area (EEA: European Economic Area) countries Iceland, Liechtenstein, and Norway and UK.

In conformance to Article 24 Section 1 – Disclosure of information on unsold consumer products, TI confirms the following information for the 2024 financial year for 2025 disclosure.
