



TI-84 Evo graphing calculator

Test preparation: Press-to-Test

Use this method when exams require calculator clearing but allow programs and applications (apps) to be disabled, rather than deleted. Calculator memory will be cleared. Access to programs and apps will be blocked. Programs and apps can be recovered after the exam.

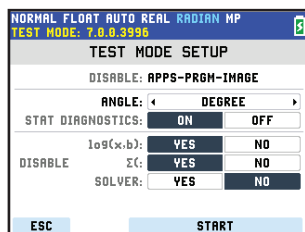
Note: The Finance app is built in and will remain after Press-to-Test is initiated.

Before the exam, put the calculator in Press-to-Test mode:

Press-to-Test will ensure that no user-saved data, programs, applications, or pictures are available during the exam.

Screens may vary slightly by Operating System (OS).

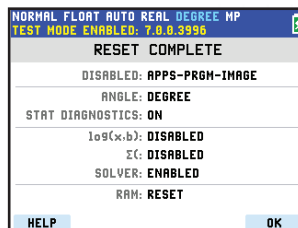
- 1) Ensure the calculator is turned off **[2nd] [off]**.
- 2) Press and hold down **[◀] [▶]** and **[on]** keys simultaneously.
- 3) Release all three keys and the TEST MODE SETUP screen will open.



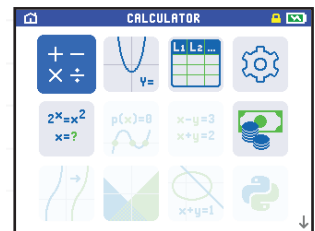
By default, ANGLE is set to DEGREE, STAT DIAGNOSTICS is ON, DISABLE

$\log(x,b)$ and summation are set to YES, and DISABLE SOLVER is set to NO. To change options, use arrow keys to navigate to desired setting and press **[enter]**.

- 4) Select **START** by pressing the **[zoom]**, **[trace]**, or **[graph]** key.
- 5) When the RESET COMPLETE screen appears, select **OK** by pressing the **[graph]** key.



- 6) The calculator Home screen will appear. Applications not accessible while in Test Mode are grayed out.

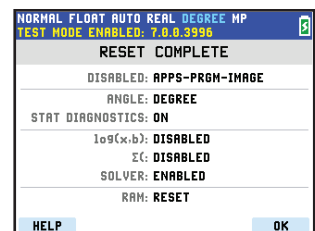


After each exam, reset Press-to-Test mode:

If the calculator is in Press-to-Test mode and is to be used in subsequent exams, you can reset Press-to-Test to clear all data and files created during the previous exam.

- 1) Turn off the calculator while in Press-to-Test mode **[2nd] [off]**.
- 2) Press and hold down **[◀] [▶]** and **[on]** keys simultaneously.
- 3) When the RESET COMPLETE screen appears, select **OK** by pressing the **[graph]** key.

The calculator is now ready for the next test.

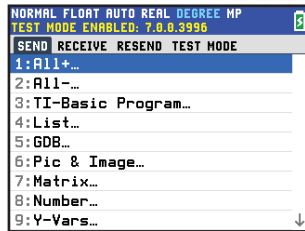


After the exam, exit Press-to-Test mode:

If the calculator will not be used in subsequent exams, exiting Press-to-Test will return user access to any programs, applications, variables, or images that were stored on the calculator prior to testing.

- 1) Connect the calculator in Test Mode to another TI-84 Evo with a unit-to-unit USB-C cable.

On the calculator that is in Test Mode, press **[2nd]**, then **[link]**.

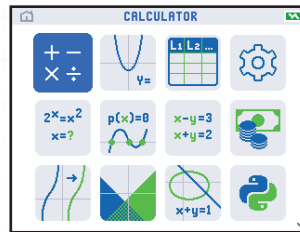


- 2) Press the left or right arrow keys to select the TEST MODE tab.



Press the **[enter]** key to select option **1: Exit Test Mode**. When complete, the TEST MODE ENABLED message at the top is no longer present.

- 3) Return to the Home screen to confirm that the device is restored with full access to Apps.



Alternate method:

- 1) Plug your TI-84 Evo into a computer using the computer-to-calculator USB cable included with your calculator.
- 2) Visit the TI Connect™ Evo online application at connectevo.ti.com.
- 3) Select the EXIT TEST MODE tool, and then select EXIT TEST MODE.
